ORDER

Date: 29 July, 2024

1. Maharashtra State Power Generation Company Ltd (MSPGCL) filed this Petition on 13 June 2023 seeking transfer of 100 MW_{ac} cumulative capacity of grid interactive Solar PV power projects awarded with EESL under MSKVY to MAHAPREIT.
2. Vide its affidavit dated 12 June 2024, MSPGCL stated as follows:
 - 2.1. During the pendency of the Petition, MSEDCL terminated the Power Supply Agreement (PSA) vide its letter dated 08 September 2023. MSEDCL categorically communicated that MSEB Holding Co. Ltd. has formed a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) MSEB Solar Agro Power Ltd (MSAPL) for implementation of MSKVY 2.0 scheme. Henceforth, MSAPL is responsible for all activities related to MSKVY. Further, all the AG dominated substations for solarization are considered under MSKVY 2.0 scheme including substations covered under 100 MW_{ac} PSA under present Petition.
 - 2.2. Due to termination of PPA by MSEDCL and inclusion of all AG dominated substations (which includes proposed project) in MSKVY 2.0 scheme, MSPGCL is not in position to progress on the project. Hence, the Petition filed by MSPGCL on 13 June 2023 has become infructuous.
 - 2.3. Accordingly, MSPGCL sought permission of the Commission to withdraw the Petition.
3. In view of the above submission, the Commission allows MSPGCL to withdraw present Petition.
4. Hence, the following Order.


ORDER

The Petition in Case No. 148 of 2023 is disposed of as withdrawn.
